
IEEE ONLINE PRODUCTS AGREEMENT (ACADEMIC)

The Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, Incorporated ("IEEE")



The Regents of the University of California, with its principal offices at The California Digital Library ("Licensee")



In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Agreement and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Definitions.

- (a) "Article" means an individual document from the Licensed Products, excluding eBooks.
- (b) "Authorized Sites" means the locations identified in Schedule B.
- (c) "Authorized Users" means (1) persons affiliated with Licensee as students, faculty or employees, regardless of the physical location of such persons; (2) authorized persons physically present in Licensee's facilities; and (3) such other persons as **IEEE** may, at the request of Licensee and in IEEE's sole discretion, authorize in writing to access the Licensed Products.
- (d) "Discovery Service Systems" means the user interface and search systems for discovering and displaying content from local, database and web-based sources.
- (e) "eBook" means an electronic book published in PDF format and made available by IEEE through IEEE Xplore.
- (f) "Invoice" means the invoice issued by IEEE or its authorized representative to Licensee setting forth the License Fee due pursuant to this Agreement.
 - (g) "Licensed Products" means the IEEE online product(s) selected in Schedule A.
- (h) "Remote Access" means access provided by Licensee via secured authentication means only to students, faculty or employees of Licensee based at an Authorized Site who are not physically present at that Authorized Site.
- (i) "Service Date" means the start date designated in the first Invoice issued under this Agreement by IEEE or its authorized representative to Licensee.
- 2. License Fee. As consideration for the rights granted by IEEE pursuant to this Agreement, Licensee shall pay IEEE the fees set forth in the accompanying Invoice in accordance with the terms set forth therein.

3. License.

- (a) <u>License Grant</u>. Subject to Licensee's compliance in all material respects with the terms and conditions of this Agreement, IEEE grants Licensee a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the Licensed Products and to provide access to the Licensed Products electronically via the Internet only to Authorized Users at Authorized Sites or via Remote Access in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- (b) <u>Authorized Uses</u>. Licensee and its Authorized Users may access and use the Licensed Products only for scholarly and research purposes and only as follows:
 - (1) access, search, browse, display and view the Licensed Products;
 - (2) download and print individual Articles and make a reasonable number of photocopies of a printed Article;

- (3) print a reasonable number of pages from an eBook and make a reasonable number of photocopies of those printed pages;
- (4) forward links to individual Articles and eBooks to Authorized Users;
- (5) post a reasonable number of Articles or eBooks per semester, per course in PDF or HTML format for the purposes of electronic course reserves on Licensee's internal, secured computer network accessible only to Authorized Users, or print a reasonable portion of the Licensed Products for print course reserves;
- (6) as part of the practice commonly known as "interlibrary loan," deliver a reasonable number of copies of Articles (including through use of Ariel or a substantially similar interlibrary loan transmission software) to fulfill requests from non-commercial, academic libraries provided, however, that such practice: (i) complies with Section 108 of the U.S. Copyright Act and the guidelines developed by the National Commission on New Technological Uses of Copyrighted Works (CONTU Guidelines); (ii) does not result in systematic reproduction of the Licensed Products, any journal or issue of a journal, any Article, or any portion of the foregoing; and (iii) must not be used for any IEEE Standards;
- (7) Licensee and Authorized Users may distribute single copies of individual Articles or pages of eBooks, in print, to Authorized Users. For the avoidance of doubt, classroom handouts shall include the distribution of a copy for teaching purposes to all individual Authorized Users in a class at Authorized Sites;
- (8) Licensee and Authorized Users shall be permitted to extract or use information contained in the Licensed Products for educational, scientific, or research purposes, including extraction and manipulation of information for the purpose of illustration, explanation, example, comment, criticism, teaching, research, or analysis with proper citations.;
- (9) Licensee and Authorized Users may use a reasonable portion of the Licensed Products in the preparation of course packs or other educational materials;
- (10) Licensee and Authorized Users may provide hyperlinks from the Licensee's and Authorized Users' web page(s) or web site(s) to individual units of content within the Licensed Products;
- (11) Authorized Users may transmit to a third party in hard copy, minimal, insubstantial amounts of the Licensed Products for personal use or scholarly, educational, or scientific research or professional use but in no case for resale or commercial purposes;
- (12) Authorized Users may use the Licensed Products to perform and engage in text and/or data mining activities for academic research, scholarship, and other educational purposes and may utilize and share the results of text and/or data mining in their scholarly work and make the results available for use by others, so long as the purpose is not to create a product for use by third parties that would substitute for the Licensed Products, with prior written approval by IEEE. Licensee shall provide IEEE with the nature of the project, the estimated duration, the content in which will be analyzed and written confirmation that derivative works shall be used strictly for non-commercial purposes.
- (13) Licensee and Authorized Users may use, with appropriate credit, figures, tables, and brief excerpts from the Licensed Products in the Authorized User's own scientific, scholarly, and educational works. For the avoidance of doubt, Licensee and Authorized Users may use citation and abstract information in faculty profiling systems, in lists of publications on faculty and institutional web pages, and to create bibliographies.
- (c) No Diminution of Rights. Nothing in this Agreement, including but not limited to Authorized Uses, shall be interpreted to diminish the rights and privileges of the Licensee or Authorized Users with respect to any of the Licensed Products, including exceptions or limitations to the exclusive rights of copyright owners, such as fair use, under Section 107 of the U.S. Copyright Act.
- (d) <u>Unlimited Access.</u> Subject to the terms of this Agreement, Licensee and its Authorized Users shall have unlimited simultaneous user access to the Licensed Products.
- (e) Restrictions. Except as expressly permitted in this Agreement, Licensee and its Authorized Users may not: (1) download, reproduce, retain or redistribute the Licensed Products or any journal or issue of a journal in the Licensed Products in its entirety or in any substantial or systematic manner, including, but not limited to, accessing the Licensed Products using a robot, spider, crawler, screen scraping or similar technological device; (2) electronically distribute, via e-mail or otherwise, any Article or eBook; (3) abridge, modify, translate or create any derivative work based upon the Licensed Products without the prior written consent of IEEE; (4) display or otherwise make available any part of the Licensed Products to anyone other than Authorized Users; (5) sell, resell,

rent, lease, license, sublicense, assign or otherwise transfer any rights granted under this Agreement, including, but not limited to, use of the Licensed Products for document delivery, fee-for-service or any other substantially similar commercial purpose; or (6) remove, obscure or modify in any way copyright notices, other notices or disclaimers that appear on Articles or eBooks or in the Licensed Products.

(f) <u>Change in Number of Authorized Users</u>. If Licensee acquires additional corporations or subsidiaries or merges with another entity and wishes to provide access to the additional locations, a fee increase commensurate with such change may be required before access and use of the Licensed Products is provided to or for the benefit of the additional user population, Authorized Users and/or Authorized Sites. Likewise, if Licensee divests a significant operating group, division, or affiliate, then this Agreement may be subject to renegotiation.

4. IEEE Performance Obligations.

- (a) Availability of License Materials. Upon the Effective Date of this Agreement, IEEE will make the Licensed Products available to the Licensee and Authorized Users. The Licensed Products may be subject to periodic unavailability due to regular maintenance, including, but not limited to, maintenance of the server(s) and other equipment used to host the Licensed Products, installation or testing of software and loading of content as it becomes available. IEEE shall use commercially reasonable efforts to minimize the extent of any period of unavailability due to such regular maintenance. Licensee shall not be entitled to any credit, reduction or set-off against the License Fee for downtime or any interruption in the availability of the Licensed Products unless such interruption exceeds twenty-four (24) continuous hours in duration. In such event, IEEE shall provide Licensee with a credit equal to 1/365 of the annual License Fee for each continuous twenty-four (24) hour period from the time of interruption until restoration of Licensee's access to the Licensed Products, provided that Licensee promptly notifies IEEE in writing of the service interruption. No credit will be issued for accumulating periods of non-continuous interruptions or any interruption caused by any negligence or willful misconduct of Licensee or failure of equipment, software or services not provided by IEEE.
- (b) <u>Discovery of Licensed Products.</u> At the request of the Licensee, IEEE shall make best efforts to make the Licensed Products available through Licensee's Discovery Service System(s) for indexing and discovery purposes. IEEE shall make best efforts to provide to Licensee's discovery service vendors the citation and complete descriptive metadata (including all subject headings, abstracts, and keywords), and full-text content necessary to facilitate optimal discovery and accessibility of the content for the benefit of Licensee and Authorized Users.
- (c) <u>Persistent Linking</u>. IEEE will comply with the most current version of the OpenURL standard (ANSI/NISA Z39.88).
- (d) Online Terms and Conditions. In the event that IEEE requires Authorized Users to agree to additional terms relating to the use of the Licensed Products (commonly referred to as "click-through" or "clickwrap" licenses), or otherwise attempts to impose terms on Authorized Users through online terms and conditions invoked by the mere use or viewing of the Licensed Products, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall govern in the event of a conflict between the additional terms and this Agreement. For the avoidance of doubt, Authorized Users are not a party to this Agreement.
- (e) <u>Documentation.</u> IEEE will provide complete and up-to-date help and operational documentation for Licensee and Authorized Users in an electronic format.
- (f) <u>Support.</u> IEEE will offer reasonable levels of continuing support to assist Licensee and Authorized Users in use of the Licensed Products. IEEE will make its personnel available by email and/or phone during Licensee's regular business hours, Monday through Friday, for feedback, problem-solving, or general questions and will respond in a timely manner.
- (g) <u>Training</u>. At the request of the Licensee, IEEE will provide appropriate training to Licensee and its' Authorized Users relating to the use of the Licensed Products and the Xplore platform, as well as training made necessary by any updates or modifications to the Licensed Products or the Xplore platform.
- (h) <u>Withdrawal of Licensed Products.</u> IEEE reserves the right to withdraw from the Licensed Products content that it no longer retains or has the right to license, or that it has reasonable grounds to believe is unlawful, harmful, false or infringing. If the withdrawal represents more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the content of the Licensed Products or if any such withdrawal renders the Licensed Products substantially less useful to Licensee or its Authorized Users, then Licensee has the right to terminate the Agreement and shall be entitled to a refund of any fees or pro-rata portion thereof paid by Licensee for any remaining period of the Agreement from the date of termination.

- (i) <u>Usage Statistics.</u> IEEE must provide both composite system wide use data and itemized data for individual campuses and labs, on a monthly basis. Statistics shall meet or exceed the most recent project Counting Online Usage of NeTworked Electronic Resources (COUNTER) Code of Practice Release, including but not limited to its provisions on customer confidentiality. When a release of a new COUNTER Codes of Practice is issued, IEEE shall comply with the implementation time frame specified by COUNTER to provide use statistics in the new standard format.
- celating to the usage of the Licensed Products by Licensee and its Authorized Users. Such data may be used solely for purposes directly related to the Licensed Products and may only be provided to third parties in aggregate form. Raw usage date, including but not limited to information relating to the identity of specific users and/or uses shall not be provided to any third party. Notwithstanding the foregoing: (i) IEEE shall be permitted to employ a third-party vendor to collect and analyze usage statistics concerning the Licensed Products, provided that such vendor abides by the restrictions herein; and (ii) IEEE and the third-party vendor described in subsection (i) herein may disclose user data if required by a governmental agency or by operation of law, provided that IEEE or such vendor gives Licensee reasonable prior written notice sufficient to permit the Licensee to contest such disclosure.
- (k) Accessibility. IEEE strives to provide an accessible web presence to all people, regardless of disabilities. To support this commitment, IEEE has adopted the W3C's Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0 Level A as the enterprise Web Accessibility objective. However, IEEE Web publishers are encouraged to deliver content at higher accessibility levels (Level AA or Level AAA) whenever possible. IEEE shall make reasonable efforts to promptly respond to and resolve any complaint regarding accessibility of License Products.

5. Intellectual Property Rights.

- (a) <u>Ownership</u>. Licensee acknowledges and agrees that all right, title and interest in and to the Licensed Products, including all copyright and other intellectual property rights under United States and international laws and treaties, remain with IEEE and its licensors.
- (b) <u>Protection</u>. Licensee recognizes the value of the Licensed Products and agrees that unauthorized use and access may substantially harm IEEE. To prevent this, Licensee agrees that:
- (1) Licensee shall make reasonable efforts to advise all Authorized Users of IEEE's rights and restrictions on the use of the Licensed Products, including those set forth in Sections 3(a) and 5(a).
- (2) In the event that Licensee becomes aware of any unauthorized use of the Licensed Products, including but not limited to, by way of Licensee's IP addresses, equipment or other facilities, Licensee shall promptly give written notice to IEEE of such unauthorized use and use its commercially reasonable best efforts to eliminate such unauthorized use.
- (3) Licensee shall at all times implement appropriate security policies, procedures, access control methodologies and network protection techniques to safeguard access to the Licensed Products. All such measures shall comply with prevailing industry standards but in no case consist of less than reasonable care.
- (4) IEEE shall have the right to inquire about the security procedures being used by Licensee and suggest improvements.

6. Term and Termination.

- (a) Term. Unless terminated sooner in accordance with Section 6(b), this Agreement shall continue in effect for an initial term of twelve (12) months from the Service Date (the "Initial Term"). Licensee may renew the Agreement for additional twelve (12)-month periods, unless otherwise specified, (each, a "Renewal Term") upon written notice to IEEE and payment of the annual license fee, as determined by IEEE, within thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the Initial Term or any Renewal Term. In the event that Licensee elects to not renew, Licensee shall notify IEEE at least thirty (30) days prior to the Renewal Term.
- (b) <u>Termination</u>. Notwithstanding the terms of Section 6(a), this Agreement may be terminated as follows:
- (1) Material Breach. Either party may terminate this Agreement in the event of a material breach by the other party that remains uncured sixty (60) days after the non-breaching party gives the breaching party written notice of such breach.

- (2) Suspension. In the event that IEEE notifies Licensee of a material breach of Section 3(e)(1), IEEE reserves the right to suspend Licensee's access to the Licensed Products. IEEE will make commercially reasonable efforts to limit suspension to the offending IP address or user account, to the extent that the offending IP address or user account can be reasonably ascertained under the circumstances; otherwise, IEEE reserves the right to suspend all online access to the Licensed Products by Licensee. The suspension shall remain in effect until Licensee has cured the material breach, and Licensee shall not be entitled to a refund of any fees during such suspension. If Licensee does not cure the material breach within sixty (60) days after notice of such breach, IEEE shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement immediately.
- (3) *Insolvency*. Either party may terminate this Agreement without penalty in the event that the other party becomes insolvent or bankrupt; becomes the subject of any proceedings under bankruptcy, insolvency or debtor's relief law; has a receiver or manager appointed; makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors; or takes the benefit of any applicable law or statute in force for the winding up or liquidation of such party's business.
- (c) <u>Events Upon Termination</u>. Upon termination of this Agreement, Licensee shall make reasonable efforts to delete all electronic copies of Articles and eBooks that are in its possession or control, except as otherwise provided in Section 10 Post Cancellation Access. Licensee may continue to use print copies of Articles and excerpts from eBooks made in accordance with the terms and conditions herein during the term of this Agreement, provided that Section 3(c) shall continue to govern use of such materials.

7. Representations and Warranties and Indemnities.

- (a) Representations and Warranties. IEEE and Licensee each represents and warrants to the other that:
 (a) it has the necessary power and authority to enter into this Agreement; (b) the execution and performance of this Agreement has been authorized by all necessary corporate or institutional action; (c) entry into and performance of this Agreement will not conflict with any provision of law or the certificate of incorporation, by-laws or comparable organizational documents of the party or conflict with any condition of any contract to which it is a party; (d) no action by any governmental organization is necessary to make this Agreement valid and binding upon the party; and (e) it possesses all licenses and other governmental approvals necessary to perform its obligations under this Agreement.
- (b) <u>Indemnities</u>. IEEE shall indemnify and hold harmless the Licensee and Authorized Users for any losses, claims, damages, awards, penalties, or injuries incurred, including reasonable attorney's fees, that arise from any third party claim that alleges copyright infringement or other intellectual property infringement arising from the use of the Licensed Products by the Licensee or any Authorized User. NO LIMITATION OF LIABILITY SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS AGREEMENT IS APPLICABLE TO THIS INDEMNIFICATION. This Section shall survive the termination of this Agreement.
- 8. DISCLAIMER. THE LICENSED PRODUCTS ARE PROVIDED TO LICENSEE "AS IS" AND "WITH ALL FAULTS." IEEE, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES AND REPRESENTATIONS (EXCEPT AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 7), EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION: (A) THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE; AND (B) ANY WARRANTY WITH RESPECT TO THE QUALITY, ACCURACY, CURRENCY OR COMPLETENESS OF THE LICENSED PRODUCTS, OR THAT LICENSEE'S USE OF THE LICENSED PRODUCTS WILL BE ERROR-FREE, UNINTERRUPTED, FREE FROM OTHER FAILURES OR WILL MEET LICENSEE'S REQUIREMENTS. LICENSEE ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT THE CONTENTS OF THE LICENSED PRODUCTS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

9. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.

- (a) IN NO EVENT SHALL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER PARTY FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES ARISING FROM ANY TYPE OR MANNER OF COMMERCIAL, BUSINESS OR FINANCIAL LOSS OCCASIONED BY OR RESULTING FROM ANY USE OF THE LICENSED PRODUCTS, SUCH AS ANY MALFUNCTION, DEFECT OR FAILURE OF THE LICENSED PRODUCTS OR THEIR DELIVERY VIA THE INTERNET, EVEN IF SUCH PARTY HAD ACTUAL OR CONSTRUCTIVE KNOWLEDGE OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES AND REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH DAMAGES WERE FORESEEABLE.
- (b) IEEE UNDERTAKES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR, AND DISCLAIMS ALL LIABILITY ARISING FROM, ANY DEFECTS OR FAILURES IN ANY COMMUNICATIONS LINES, THE INTERNET OR INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDER, LICENSEE'S COMPUTER HARDWARE OR SOFTWARE, OR ANY OTHER SERVICE OR DEVICE USED TO ACCESS THE LICENSED PRODUCTS OR TO AUTHENTICATE ANY USER AS AN

AUTHORIZED USER. LICENSEE ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT IEEE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACCURACY OF ANY INFORMATION OR DATA CONTAINED IN THE LICENSED PRODUCTS, AND IEEE SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY LOSSES OR DAMAGES RESULTING FROM RELIANCE ON ANY SUCH INFORMATION OR DATA UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

10. Post Cancellation Access. Upon termination of this Agreement, except in the event of termination by IEEE pursuant to Section 6(b), and payment of the applicable fees, IEEE shall provide Licensee with a non-exclusive, non-transferrable and perpetual license to use and provide access to a portion of the Licensed Products published during the years in which Licensee maintained an active subscription to an IEEE Licensed Product. IEEE shall provide access to the Licensed Products either online, via the internet, or offline, via one (1) static copy on a fixed medium. To the extent that the portion of the Licensed Products includes any of the following, such access shall not include access to any IEEE Standards Online Packages, eBooks, IET content in offline format or content licensed by IEEE from third party content providers or for which IEEE otherwise does not have the right to provide archival access.

11. General.

- (a) Notice. Notices given under this Agreement shall be in writing and may be delivered by hand or sent by internationally-recognized courier service, e-mail or fax to the physical address, e-mail address or facsimile number for each party set forth on the first page of this Agreement. Any such notice shall be deemed successfully given: (1) if delivered personally, at the time of delivery; (2) in the case of an internationally-recognized courier service, on the date of delivery confirmation; or (3) in the case of e-mail or facsimile, at the time of successful transmission. Either party may from time to time change its Notice Address by written notice to the other party. Any legal notices or other legal documents provided to either party as described above shall constitute valid legal service and IEEE expressly waives any further service of process otherwise required under the Hague convention.
- (b) <u>Assignment</u>. Neither party may not assign this Agreement, or sublicense, assign or delegate any right or obligation hereunder, by operation of law or otherwise, without the prior written consent of the other party.
- (c) <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement, including all annexes, exhibits and schedules, contains the final and entire agreement of the parties on the subject matter herein and supersedes all previous and contemporaneous oral or written negotiations or agreements on the subject matter herein.
- (d) <u>Amendment</u>. This Agreement may not be amended except in a writing executed by an authorized representative of each party.
- (e) <u>Governing Law</u>. This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed according to, and governed by, the laws of California, excluding any such laws that might direct the application of the laws of another jurisdiction.
- (f) Dispute Resolution & Venue. In the event of any dispute or controversy arising out of or refating to this Agreement, the parties agree to exercise good faith efforts to resolve the dispute as soon as possible. If the dispute is not resolved within thirty (30) calendar days of the meeting among the parties' executives, either party may pursue a legal action in court. During such court action, the parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under this Agreement that are not affected by the dispute.
- (g) <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Agreement shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable under applicable law, then such provision shall be construed, limited, modified or, if necessary, severed to the extent necessary to eliminate its unenforceability. Such provision shall be ineffective to the extent of such invalidity or unenforceability only, without in any way affecting the remaining parts of this Agreement.
- (h) <u>Force Majeure</u>. Any prevention of or delay in either party's performance hereunder due to labor disputes, acts of God, governmental restrictions, enemy or hostile governmental action, fire or other casualty or other causes beyond such party's reasonable control shall excuse such party's performance of its obligations hereunder for a period equal to the duration of any such prevention or delay.
- (i) <u>Non-Waiver</u>. The failure of either party to require strict performance by the other party of any provision hereof shall not affect the full right to require such performance at any time thereafter, nor shall the waiver by either party of a breach of any provision hereof be taken or held to be a waiver of the provision itself.
- (j) <u>Survival</u>. The provisions of this Agreement that should by their nature survive termination of this Agreement shall survive such termination, including, but not limited to, Sections 3(e), 5, 6(c), 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11.,
- (k) <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.


