Archive Capital Fee

The above total Annual Access Fee for the first year shall be prorated to reflect the number of months remaining in the calendar year following the date of this Rider and shall be due and payable thirty (30) days after the date of invoice. The Annual Access Fees are subject to reasonable annual increases.

Any payments made more than thirty (30) days after they are due and payable shall be subject to annual interest charge. All payments shall be made by check payable to JSTOR.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
