

**AMENDMENT**

JSTOR and The Regents of the University of California hereby amend the terms of the Agreement entitled JSTOR LIBRARY LICENSE AGREEMENT dated September 1, 1998 (the "Agreement") such that,

*dated October 11, 2002*

Paragraph 3.5 and its related Amendment ~~is~~ deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following paragraph 3.5:

3.5 It is understood that Licensee may wish to use the Archive for the purpose of fulfilling occasional requests from other collections, a practice commonly called Interlibrary Loan. Licensee may use Materials from the Archive in Interlibrary Loan in accordance with the Copyright Act of the U.S. Transmission of printed Materials through post or fax, or secure, self-deleting electronic transmission, such as Ariel or its equivalent, may be used in Interlibrary Loan. JSTOR shall provide, in a publicly accessible area of the Archive, information to facilitate direct contacts with publishers for the provision of Materials or for other permissions.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
