STANDARD PURCHASE AGREEMENT

SAGE PUBLICATIONS AND THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA

THIS BACKFILE PURCHASE AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is effective as of Ianuary 1, 2008 (the "Effective Date"), and is entered into by and between SAGE Publications, Inc., a Delaware corporation, with offices at 2455 Teller Road, Thousand Oaks, CA 91320 ("SAGE") and The Regents of the University of California, a non-profit academic institution, with offices at The California Digital Library, University of California, Office of the President, 415 20th Street, 4th Floor, Oakland, CA 94612 ("Purchaser") (collectively referred to herein as the "Parties").

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

I. CONTENT OF PURCHASED MATERIALS; GRANT OF PURCHASE

The materials that are the subject of this Agreement shall consist of the electronic versions of journals published by SAGE in specified backfile years prior to 1999 as set forth on Exhibit 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Content"). The Content does not include any additional journals, publications, or other content not specifically identified on Exhibit 1.

Purchaser and its Authorized Users acknowledge that the copyright in and title to the Content and any trademarks or service marks relating thereto are proprietary and remain the sole property of SAGE. Neither Purchaser nor its Authorized Users shall have any right, title or interest in the Content except as expressly set forth in this Agreement.

SAGE hereby grants to Purchaser and its Authorized Users the non-exclusive, non-transferable, perpetual right to continuing functional online access and use of the Content via SAGE Journals Online (powered by HighWire Press or its successor hosting services as SAGE may designate in its sole discretion).

II. DELIVERY/ACCESS OF CONTENT TO PURCHASER

SAGE will provide the Content to the Purchaser in the following manner:

<u>Network Access.</u> The Content will be stored at one or more SAGE locations in digital form accessible by telecommunications links between such locations and authorized locations of Purchaser.

III. FEES

Purchaser shall make payment to SAGE for purchase of the Content as follows:

THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is effective as of January 1, 2008 (the "Effective Date"), and is entered into by and between SAGE Publications, Inc., a Delaware corporation, with offices at 2455 Teller Road, Thousand Oaks, CA 91320 ("SAGE") and The Regents of the University of California, a non-profit academic institution, with offices at The California Digital Library, University of California, Office of the President, 415 20th Street, 4th Floor, Oakland, CA 94612 ("Licensee").

WHEREAS, Licensee entered into a certain license agreement dated January 1, 2005, with SAGE and Cambridge Scientific Abstracts regarding access to electronic information published by SAGE, which agreement terminated, by its terms, on December 31, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Licensee and SAGE wish to enter into a new license agreement regarding access to electronic information published by SAGE, on the terms and conditions as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledge, Licensee and SAGE agree as follows:

I. CONTENT OF LICENSED MATERIALS; GRANT OF LICENSE

The materials that are subject to this Agreement are electronic information published by SAGE (hereinafter referred to as the "Licensed Materials"), as set for on Exhibit 1. The Licensed Materials are digitized versions of the full text content of the SAGE journals listed on Exhibit 1 and consist of (a) certain full text collections (the "Collections") and (b) journals that are not part of the Collections ("Plus Titles").

Licensee and its Authorized Users acknowledge that the copyright and title to the Licensed Materials and trademarks or service marks relating thereto remain with SAGE. Neither Licensee nor its Authorized Users shall have any right, title or interest in the Licensed Materials except as expressly set forth in this Agreement.

In the event any Licensee institution wishes to obtain print access to any of the Licensed Materials, the institution shall contact SAGE directly. SAGE will give such Licensee institutions an 85% discount from its published retail print list prices. In order to receive this discount, the institutions (or their subscription agents, if applicable) must notify SAGE of their interest, providing a complete list of all titles that they wish to receive. SAGE hereby grants to Licensee a non-exclusive, worldwide, nontransferable, perpetual right to use the Licensed Materials and provide the Licensed Materials to Authorized Users via SAGE Journals Online in accordance with this Agreement.

II. DELIVERY/ACCESS OF LICENSED MATERIALS TO LICENSE

SAGE will provide the Licensed Materials to the Licensee in the following manner:

Network Access. During the term of this Agreement, the Licensed Materials will be stored on SAGE Journals Online, SAGE's proprietary online delivery platform, in digital form accessible by telecommunications links between such location and authorized locations of Licensee. In addition, during the period January 2008 through December 2009, the Collections will also be stored with Cambridge Science Abstracts ("CSA") and accessible via CSA Illumina, CSA's proprietary Internet platform, by telecommunications links between such location and authorized locations of Licensee.

During the term of this Agreement, Licensee and its Authorized Users will obtain access to the Collections and the Plus Titles via SAGE Journals Online. In addition, during the period January 2008 through December 2009, Licensee and its Authorized Users may also obtain access to the Collections via CSA Illumina.

III. FEES AND BUSINESS TERMS

The fees that shall apply during the term of this Agreement are set forth on Schedule A.

SAGE shall invoice Licensee directly for all fees. Licensee shall pay each invoice within sixty (60) days after the date of such invoice.

Additional Business Terms are set forth on Schedule A.

IV. AUTHORIZED USE OF LICENSED MATERIALS

Authorized Users. "Authorized Users" are:

<u>Persons Affiliated with the University of California</u>. Full and part time employees (including faculty, staff, and independent contractors) and students of Licensee and the institution of which it is a part, regardless of the physical location of such persons. For campus locations see Appendix A.

Walk-ins. Patrons not affiliated with Licensee who are physically present at Licensee's site(s) ("walk-ins").

Access by and Authentication of Authorized Users. Licensee and its Authorized Users shall be granted access to the Licensed Materials pursuant to the following:

IP Address. Authorized User's shall be identified and authenticated by the use of Internet Protocol ("P") addressed provided by Licensee to SAGE (and, if applicable, CSA). The use of proxy servers is permitted as long as any proxy server IP addresses provided limit remote or off-campus access to Authorized Users.

<u>Authorized Uses.</u> Licensee and Authorized Users may make all use of the Licensed Materials as is consistent with the Fair Use provisions of United States and international copyright laws. In addition, the Licensed Materials may be used for purposes of research, education or other non-commercial use as follows:

<u>Display</u>. Licensee and Authorized Users may electronically display the Licensed Materials.

<u>Digitally Copy.</u> Licensee and Authorized Users may download and digitally copy a reasonable portion of the Licensed Materials.

<u>Print Copy.</u> Licensee and Authorized Users may print a reasonable portion of the Licensed Materials.

<u>Recover Copying Costs</u>. Licensee may charge a reasonable fee to cover costs of copying or printing portions of Licensed Materials for Authorized Users.

Archival/Backup Copy. Upon request of Licensee, Licensee may receive from SAGE and/or create one (1) copy of the entire set of Licensed Materials to be maintained as a backup or archival copy during the term of this Agreement, or as required to exercise Licensee's rights under Section XII Perpetual License, of this Agreement.

SAGE acknowledges that Licensee may engage the services of third-party trusted archives and/or participate in collaborative archiving endeavors to exercise Licensee's rights under section XII, 'Perpetual License', of this Agreement. SAGE agrees to cooperate with such archiving entities and/or initiatives as reasonably necessary to make the Licensed Materials available for archiving purposes. Licensee may perpetually use the third-party trusted system to access or store the Licensed Materials, so long as Licensee's use is otherwise consistent with this Agreement. SAGE further acknowledges and agrees that, in using the third-party archival system, Licensed Materials may be made available to other system participants who indicate a right to those Licensed Materials.

<u>Caching</u>. Licensee and Authorized Users may make local digital copies of the Licensed Materials in order to ensure efficient use by Authorized Users by appropriate browser or other software.

Collections of Information. Licensee and Authorized Users may extract or use information contained in the Licensed Materials for education, scientific, or research purposes, including extraction and manipulation of information for the purpose of illustration, explanation, example, comment, criticism, teaching, research or analysis.

<u>Course Packs.</u> Licensee and Authorized Users may use a reasonable portion of the Licensed Materials in the preparation of Course Packs or other educational materials.

<u>Course Research (Print and Electronic)</u>. Licensee and Authorized Users may use a reasonable portion of the Licensed Materials for use in connection with specific courses of instruction offered by the University of California.

Electronic Links. The University of California is committed to the use of the emerging OpenURL standard to allow linking to related materials in other locations. If SAGE does not use the OpenURL standard, their staff will provide information to Licensee upon request to assist the Licensee in creating links directly from UC's library catalogs and licensed resources to the content of the Licenseed Materials at the journal, issue and article levels.

Scholarly Sharing. Authorized Users may transmit to a third party in hard copy or electronically, minimal, insubstantial amounts of the Licensed Materials for personal use or scholarly, education, or scientific research or professional use but in no case for resale or commercial purposes.

Interlibrary Loan. Licensee may fulfill occasional requests from other institutions, a practice commonly called Interlibrary Loan. Licensee agrees to fulfill such requests in compliance with Section 108 of the United States Copyright Law (17 USC §108, "Limitations on exclusive rights: Reproduction by libraries and archives") and the Guidelines for the Proviso of Subsection 108(2g)(2) prepared by the National Commission on New Technological Uses of Copyrighted Works.

Amount of Authorized Use.

<u>Unlimited Access</u>. Subject to the terms of this Agreement, Licensee and its Authorized Users shall have unlimited access to the Licensed Materials.

V. SPECIFIC RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF LICENSED MATERIALS

<u>Unauthorized Use.</u> Licensee shall not knowingly permit anyone other than Authorized Users to use the Licensed Materials.

Modification of Licensed Materials. Licensee shall not modify, manipulate, or create a derivative work of any Licensed Materials without the prior written permission of SAGE.

Removal of Copyright Notice. Licensee may not remove, obscure or modify any copyright or other notices included in the Licensed Materials.

Commercial Purposes. Licensee may not use the Licensed Materials for commercial purposes, including but not limited to the sale of the Licensed Materials, fee-for-service use of the Licensed Materials, or bulk reproduction or distribution of the Licensed Materials in any form; nor may Licensee impose special charges on Authorized Users for use of the Licensed Materials beyond reasonable printing or administrative costs.

VI. MUTUAL PERFORMANCE OBLIGATIONS

<u>User Surveys.</u> SAGE and Licensee shall cooperate on the preparation and provision of user surveys to solicit feedback on the Licensed Materials from Authorized Users.

Confidentiality of User Data. SAGE and Licensee agree to maintain the confidentiality of any data relating to the usage of the Licensed Materials by Licensee and its Authorized Users. Such data may be used solely for purposes directly related to the Licensed Materials and may only be provided to third parties in aggregate form. Raw usage data, including but not limited to information relating to the identity of specific users and/or uses, shall not be provided to any third party.

Implementation of Developing Security Protocols. SAGE and Licensee shall cooperate in the implementation of security and control protocols and procedures as they are developed during the term of this Agreement. In the event that SAGE utilizes any type of digital rights management technology to control the access or the usage of Licensed Materials, SAGE agrees to notify Licensee of the name, contact information and any technical specifications for the digital rights management technology utilized.

VII. SAGE'S PERFORMANCE OBLIGATIONS

Availability of Licensed Materials. Upon the Effective Date, SAGE shall make the Licensed Materials available to Licensee and Authorized Users.

<u>Documentation</u>. SAGE will provide and maintain help files and other appropriate user documentation.

Training and Support. SAGE will offer installation support, including assisting with the installation of any SAGE software. SAGE will provide appropriate training to Licensee staff relating to the use of the Licensed Materials and any software. SAGE sill offer reasonable levels of continuing support to assist Licensee and Authorized Users in the use of the Licensed Materials. SAGE will make its personnel available by email, phone or fax during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, for feedback, problem-solving, or general questions.

Quality of Service. SAGE shall use reasonable efforts to ensure that its servers have sufficient capacity and rate of connectivity to provide Licensee and its Authorized Users with a quality of service comparable to current standards in the on-line information provision industry in Licensee's locale.

SAGE shall use reasonable efforts to provide continuous service seven (7) days a week with an average of 98% up-time per month. The 2% down-time includes periodic unavailability due to maintenance of the server(s), the installation or testing of software, the loading of additional Licensed Materials as they become available, and downtime related to the failure of equipment or services outside the control of SAGE, including but not limited to public or private telecommunications services or Internet nodes or facilities. Scheduled down-time will be performed at a time to minimize inconvenience to Licensee and its Authorized Users.

If the Licensed Materials fail to operate in conformance with the terms of this Agreement, Licensee shall immediately notify SAGE, and SAGE shall promptly use reasonable efforts to restore access to the Licensed Materials as soon as possible. In the event that SAGE fails to repair the nonconformity in a reasonable time, SAGE shall reimburse Licensee in an amount that the nonconformity is proportional to the total fees owed by Licensee under this Agreement.

Notification of Modifications of Licensed Materials. Licensee understands that from time to time the Licensed Materials may be added to, modified, or deleted from by SAGE and/or that portions of the Licensed Materials may migrate to other formats. SAGE shall give a ninety (90) day notice of any such changes to Licensee. Failure to provide such notice shall be grounds for immediate termination of this Agreement by Licensee.

Completeness of Content. Where applicable, SAGE shall use reasonable efforts to ensure that the online content is at lease equivalent to print versions of the Licensed Materials, represents complete, faithful and timely replications of the print versions of such materials, and will cooperate with Licensee to identify and correct errors and omissions.

Continued Training. SAGE will provide regular system and project updates to Licensee as they become available. SAGE will provide additional training to Licensee staff made necessary by any updates or modifications to the Licensed Materials or any software.

Notice of Terms of "Click-Through" License. In the event that SAGE requires Authorized Users to agree to terms relating to the use of the Licensed Materials before permitting Authorized Users to gain access to the Licensed Materials (commonly referred to as "click-through" licenses), SAGE shall provide Licensee with notice of, and an opportunity to comment on, such terms prior to their implementation. In no event shall the terms of such "click-through" licenses materially differ from the provisions of this Agreement. In the event of any conflict between the terms of such "click-through" licenses and this Agreement, the terms of this Agreement shall prevail.

Compliance with Americans with Disabilities Act. SAGE shall make reasonable efforts to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Licensee and its Authorized Users acknowledge and agree that the above obligations refer to SAGE Journals Online only.

VIII. LICENSEE PERFORMANCE OBLIGATIONS

Provision of Notice of License Terms to Authorized Users. Licensee shall make reasonable efforts to provide Authorized Users with appropriate notice of the terms and conditions under which access to the Licensed Materials is granted under this Agreement including, in particular, any limitations on access or use of the Licensed Materials as set forth in this Agreement.

Provision of Notice of Intellectual Property Rights to Authorized Users. Licensee shall make reasonable efforts to provide Authorized Users with notice of any applicable intellectual property or other rights applicable to the Licensed Materials and the Internet platforms on which the Licensed Materials is being made available. Licensee shall make reasonable efforts to prevent the infringement of any intellectual property or other rights of SAGE in the Licensed Materials and SAGE Journals Online. Licensee shall promptly notify SAGE of any infringement that comes to Licensee's attention, and take appropriate steps to avoid its recurrence.

Protection from Unauthorized Use. Licensee shall use reasonable efforts to protect the Licensed Materials from any use that is not permitted under this Agreement. In the event of an unauthorized use of the Licensed Materials by an Authorized User (a) SAGE may terminate such Authorized User's access to the Licensed Materials, (b) SAGE may terminate the access of the Internet Protocol ("IP") address(es) from which such unauthorized use occurred, and/or (c) Licensee shall terminate such Authorized User's access to the Licensed Materials upon SAGE's request. SAGE shall take none of the steps described in this paragraph without first providing a sixty (60) day notice to Licensee and cooperation with Licensee to avoid recurrence of any unauthorized use.

Maintaining Confidentiality of Access Passwords. Where access to the Licensed Materials is to be controlled by use of passwords, Licensee shall issue log-on identification numbers and passwords to each Authorized User and use reasonable efforts to ensure that Authorized Users do not divulge their numbers and passwords to any third party.

IX. TERM

This Agreement shall be in effect from January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2010. [3 years]

X. RENEWAL

This Agreement shall be renewable at the end of the current term for a successive one-year period if Licensee gives written notice of its intention to renew sixty (60) days before the expiration of the current term. Any such renewal will be at the then current rates for the Licensed Materials, which SAGE shall provide Licensee upon request.

XI. EARLY TERMINATION

In the event that a party believes that the other has materially breached any obligations under this Agreement, or if SAGE believes that Licensee has exceeded the scope of the license granted herein, such party shall so notify the breaching party in writing. The breaching party shall have sixty (60) days from the receipt of notice to cure the alleged breach and to notify the non-breaching party in writing that cure has been effected. If the breach is not cured within the sixty (60) days period, the non-breaching party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement without further notice.

Upon termination of this Agreement for cause by SAGE, online access to the Licensed Materials by Licensee and Authorized Users shall be terminated immediately. Authorized copies of reasonable portions of the Licensed Materials may be retained by Licensee or Authorized Users and used subject to the terms of this Agreement.

In the event of early termination permitted by this Agreement, so long a Licensee's default has not caused the termination, Licensee shall be entitled to a refund of any fees or pro-rata portion thereof paid by Licensee for any remaining period of the term of this Agreement from the date of termination.

XII. PERPETUAL LICENSE

Notwithstanding anything else in this Agreement, SAGE hereby grants to Licensee a nonexclusive, royalty-free, perpetual license to use only the Licensed Materials published during the license term. Such use shall be in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement, which provisions shall survive any termination of this Agreement. The means by which Licensee shall have access to such Licensed Materials shall be via Licensee's own servers.

XIII. WARRANTIES

Subject to the Limitations set forth elsewhere in this Agreement:

SAGE warrants that it has the right to license the rights granted under this Agreement to the Licensed Materials, that it has obtained any and all necessary permissions from third parties to license the Licensed Materials, and that use of the Licensed Materials by Authorized Users in accordance with the terms of this Agreement will not infringe the copyright of any third party.

XIV. LIMITATIONS ON WARRANTIES

Notwithstanding anything else in this Agreement:

No party shall be liable for any indirect, special, incidental, punitive, or consequential damages, including but not limited to loss of data, business interruption, or loss or profits, arising out of the use of, or the inability to use, the Licensed Materials.

SAGE makes no representation or warranty and expressly disclaims any liability with respect to the content of any Licensed Materials, including but not limited to errors or omissions contained therein, libel, infringement of rights of publicity, privacy, trademark rights, moral rights, or the disclosure of confidential information.

Except for the express warranties stated herein, the Licensed Materials are provided on an "as is" basis, and SAGE disclaims any and all other warranties, conditions, or representations (express, implied, oral or written), relating to the Licensed Materials or any party thereof, including, without limitation, any and all implied warranties of quality, performance, merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. SAGE makes no warranties respecting any harm that my be caused by the transmission of a computer virus, worm, time bomb, logic bomb or other such computer program. SAGE further expressly disclaims any warranty or representation to Authorized Users or to any third party.

XV. INDEMNITIES

SAGE shall indemnify and hold Licensee and Authorized Users harmless for any losses, claims, damages, awards, penalties, or injuries incurred, including reasonable attorney's fees, which arise from any claim by any third party of an alleged infringement of copyright or any other property right arising out of the use of the Licensee Materials by the Licensee or any Authorized User. NO LIMITATION OF LIABILITY SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS AGREEMENT IS APPLICABLE TO THIS INDEMNIFICATION.

Each party shall indemnify and hold the other harmless for any losses, claims, damages, awards, penalties, or injuries incurred, including reasonable attorney's fees, which arise from any alleged breach of the indemnifying party's representations and warranties made under this Agreement, provided that the indemnifying party is promptly notified of any such claims.

The indemnifying party shall have the right to defend such claims at its own expense. The indemnified party shall provide assistance in investigating and defending such claims as the indemnifying party may reasonably request and have the right to participate in the defense at its own expense.

XVI. ASSIGNMENT AND TRANSFER

Neither party may assign, directly or indirectly, all or apart of its rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other party, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed.

XVII. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed according to, and governed by, the laws of California, excluding any such laws that might direct the application of the laws of another jurisdiction. The federal and state courts located in California shall have sole jurisdiction to hear any dispute under this Agreement.

XVIII. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In the event any dispute or controversy arising out of or relating to this Agreement, the parties will exercise their best efforts to resolve the dispute as soon as possible. The parties shall, without delay, continue to perform their respective obligations under this Agreement which are not affected by the dispute.

Mediation. In the event that the parties can not by exercise of their best efforts resolve the dispute, they shall submit the dispute to mediation. The parties shall, without delay, continue to perform their respective obligations under this Agreement which are not affected by the dispute. The invoking party shall give the other party written notice of its decision to do so, including a description of the issues subject to the dispute and a proposed resolution thereof. Designated representatives of both parties shall attempt to resolve the dispute within five (5) working days after such notice. If those designated representatives cannot resolve the dispute, the parties shall meet at a mutually agreeable location and describe the dispute and their respective proposals for resolution to responsible executives of the parties, who shall act in good faith to resolve the dispute. If the dispute is not resolved within thirty (30) calendar days after such meeting, the dispute shall be submitted to binding arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration provision of this Agreement.

Arbitration. Any controversies or disputes arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall be resolved by binding arbitration in accordance with the then current Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association. The parties shall endeavor to select a mutually acceptable arbitrator knowledgeable about issues relating to the subject matter of this Agreement. The arbitration shall take place at a location that is reasonably centrally located between the parties, or otherwise mutually agreed upon by the parties.

All documents, materials, and information in the possession of a party that are in any way relevant to the claim(s) or dispute(s) shall be made available to the other party for review and copying no later than sixty (60) days after the notice of arbitration is served.

The arbitrator shall not have the authority, power, or rights to alter, change, amend, modify, add, or subtract from any provision of this Agreement or to award punitive damages. The arbitrator shall have the power to issue mandatory orders and restraining orders in connection with the arbitration. The award rendered by the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties, and judgment may be entered thereon in any court having jurisdiction. The agreement to arbitration shall be specifically enforceable under prevailing arbitration law. During the continuance of any arbitration proceeding, the parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under this Agreement.

XIX. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be liable in damages or have the right to terminate this Agreement for any delay or default in performing hereunder if such delay or default is caused by conditions beyond its control including, but not limited to, government restrictions (including the denial or cancellation of any export or other necessary license), wars, insurrections, strikes or other work stoppages, acts of nature, and/or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the party whose performance is affected.

XX. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior communications, understandings and agreements relating to the subject matter hereof, whether oral or written.

XXI. AMENDMENT

No modification or claimed waiver of any provision of this Agreement shall be valid except by written amendment signed by authorized representatives of both parties hereto.

XXII. SEVERABILITY

If any provision or provisions of this Agreement shall be held to be invalid, illegal, unenforceable of in conflict with the law of any jurisdiction, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.

XXIII. WAIVER OF CONTRACTUAL RIGHT

Waiver of any provision herein shall not be deemed a waiver of any other provision herein, no shall waiver of any breach of this Agreement be construed as a continuing waiver of other breaches of the same of other provisions of this Agreement.

XXIV. FUNDING CONTINGENCY
