**ENHANCED ACCESS LICENSE
FOR WILEY INTERSCIENCE**

This License, dated as of December 1, 1999, sets forth the terms and conditions under which Wiley Subscription Services, Inc. ("Wiley"), a Delaware corporation will provide the Regents of the University of California (the "Licensee"), with access to the electronic edition of the Journal or Journals subscribed to by the Licensee via Wiley InterScience, an online service, under the following terms and conditions.

A. DEFINITIONS

The following terms shall be deemed to have the meaning as stated below:

Wiley InterScience - The online service available from Wiley or its affiliates on the Worldwide Web and all products, services and features offered through said service.

2. **Licensee** - The customer named above, as further defined in Appendix A, which has authorized the signature of this License, provides access, via its secure network, to Wiley InterScience for its Authorized Users as defined below, and is responsible for payments and implementation of the License.

The Licensee may not extend access to Wiley InterScience, through the Licensee's network, to partners, joint ventures and affiliates not specified in Appendix A, except with the prior written consent of Wiley and appropriate contractual modifications.

3. **Electronic Publications** - The electronic (online) editions of Wiley Publications including Wiley Journals ("Electronic Journals"), and the retrospective (back) and current electronic files of such Publications, such as tables of content, abstracts, full text and illustrations including any additional electronic journal content not included in the print versions of the Publications. All of the Electronic Publications available in Wiley InterScience are listed in Appendix B.
4. **Authorized Users** - Those persons who are authorized by the Licensee to have access to Wiley InterScience. Authorized Users must be bona fide faculty members, students, researchers, staff members, librarians, executives or employees of the Licensee. Walk-in Users from the general public or business invitees may also be permitted by the Licensee to access Wiley InterScience from designated terminals with a Licensee-controlled IP address. These designated terminals shall be physically located in libraries or similar premises under the Licensee's direct control and administration.

B. LICENSED ELECTRONIC PUBLICATIONS AND ACCESS PRIVILEGES

Wiley grants to the Licensee and its Authorized Users, during the Term as defined below, a non-exclusive, non-transferable right and license to access, via Wiley InterScience, the full text of the Electronic Publications listed in Appendix B as may be amended from time to time (the "Licensed Electronic Publications"), but only on the terms and conditions described herein.

2. Subscriptions to 1999, 2000, and 2001 Electronic Journal content also include access to 1997 and 1998 electronic editions of such Journals where available from Wiley through Wiley InterScience.

3. Authorized Users will also have unlimited access to all Electronic Publication websites within Wiley InterScience.
4. Authorized Users may browse all Tables of Contents and all available abstracts and websites for all Electronic Journals on Wiley InterScience regardless of which Electronic Journals the Licensee subscribes to.
5. The number of the Licensee's Authorized Users who may log onto Wiley InterScience is unlimited.
6. The Licensee acknowledges that the Electronic Publications and Wiley InterScience are protected by copyright. All rights not specifically granted to the Licensee are expressly reserved.

C. **RULES OF USE**

The rights and restrictions governing access to Wiley InterScience by the Licensee and its Authorized Users are outlined in the Rules of Use below, pursuant to section E2a.

- a. Authorized Users may download, view, copy and save to hard disk or diskette and store or print out single copies of individual articles or items for Authorized Users' own personal and non-commercial use, scholarly, educational or scientific research or study. Authorized Users may transmit to a third party colleague in hard copy or electronically, a single article or item from Wiley InterScience for personal and non-commercial use or scholarly, educational, or scientific research or study; or transmit or use such material for corporate informational purposes. In addition, Authorized Users have the right to use, with appropriate credit, figures, tables and brief excerpts from individual articles in the Licensed Electronic Publications in the Authorized User's own scientific, scholarly and educational works such as books and articles, and also in informational materials intended for customers of the Licensee.
- b. All Authorized Users have the option to create a personal Home Page which will allow them to create data files and links to Electronic Publications, articles of interest and search criteria which may be reused by them. In order to do so, the Authorized User will have to select and register a user name and password which the Authorized User must keep confidential and not disclose to or share with anyone else.
- c. Authorized Users who are members of the Licensee's faculty or staff may download and print out multiple copies of material from Licensed Electronic Publications for the purpose of making a multi-source collection of information for classroom use (course-pack) to be distributed to students at the Licensee's institution on a cost-recovery basis. Material from Licensed Electronic Publications may also be stored in electronic format in secure electronic data files for access by Authorized Users who are students at the Licensee's institution, as part of their course work, and for in-house training programs of corporate Licensees.

- d. The Licensee's library staff may print out and send single paper copies of articles from the Licensed Electronic Publications for interlibrary loan.
2. Except as provided in Paragraph (1) above, Authorized Users may not copy, distribute, transmit or otherwise reproduce material from Electronic Publications; store such material in any form or medium in a retrieval system; download and/or store an entire issue of a Licensed Electronic Publication or its equivalent; or transmit such material, directly or indirectly, for use in any paid service such as document delivery or list serve, or for use by any information brokerage or for systematic distribution, whether or not for commercial or non-profit use or for a fee or free of charge.
3. In order to protect the integrity and attribution of Wiley InterScience and the Electronic Publications, the Licensee and its Authorized Users may not remove, obscure or modify any copyright or proprietary notices, author attribution or disclaimer contained therein or on any screen display. Authorized Users may not integrate material from the Electronic Publications with other material or otherwise create derivative works in any medium. This is not meant to prohibit quotations for purposes of comment, criticism or similar scholarly purposes.
4. Authorized Users may not do anything to restrict or inhibit any other Authorized User's access to or use of Wiley InterScience and the Licensed Electronic Publications.
5. If an Authorized User fails to abide by these rules or violates any other terms or conditions of this Agreement, Wiley reserves the right in its sole discretion to suspend or terminate such Authorized User's access to Wiley InterScience and the Licensed Electronic Publications immediately without notice, in addition to any other available remedies. However, except in the case of a material breach which Wiley deems dangerous to the integrity and security of InterScience, Wiley shall give written notice to the Licensee of its intention to terminate such User's access and shall allow the Licensee and/or the User 30 days after receipt of such notice to cure the breach or agree to abide by the rules or other terms or conditions of this License.

D. FEES AND CHARGES

License Fees and other charges for online access to the Licensed Electronic Publications by the Licensee and its Authorized Users, and other services provided by Wiley InterScience, are specified in Appendix B, and supported by subscription information in Appendix C.

The Licensee may cancel Licensed Electronic Journal titles as a result of research program changes, which shall be exempt from penalty provided that such changes take effect on January 1st for the affected titles, do not exceed [REDACTED] of the License in a given calendar year, and titles at least equal in value to the cancelled titles are added to the License (as amendments to Appendix B). Cancellations will only be accepted on a calendar year basis and Wiley must be notified by the Licensee by November 1st of any such subsequent year cancellations and additions.

3. The Licensee is responsible for any charges associated with accessing Wiley InterScience and the Licensed Electronic Publications, including any computer equipment, telephone or Internet connections and access software.

E. MUTUAL OBLIGATIONS

Wiley will:

- a. make reasonable efforts to ensure uninterrupted online access to and continuous availability on a 24-hour basis of the Electronic Publications to Authorized Users in accordance with this License, and to restore access to the Electronic Publications as promptly as possible in the event of an interruption or suspension of the Wiley InterScience service; within the control of Wiley, scheduled downtime will be performed at a time to minimize inconvenience to customers worldwide.
- b. after termination of the License, provide the Licensee with access to the full text of the Licensed Electronic Publications listed in Appendix B and accessible during the Term of this License, either by continuing online access to the same material on Wiley's server or in an archival copy in the electronic medium selected by Wiley, at a cost-based fee to be mutually agreed. In the alternative, after the termination of the License, the Licensee may choose to create a single electronic copy for the purpose of archiving, for the Licensee's own internal use, and not for redistribution.

pursuant to subparagraph (b) above, grant to the Licensee, after termination, a nonexclusive, royalty-free, perpetual license to use such material in accordance with the restrictions on use specified in Paragraph C, which shall survive any termination of this Agreement.
- d. share information with the Licensee about the use by the Licensee's Authorized Users of the Electronic Publications consistent with applicable privacy laws and confidentiality requirements.
- e. use reasonable efforts to ensure that the online content is equivalent to Wiley print journals and is available prior to or no later than the print equivalent.
- f. use reasonable efforts to cooperate with the Licensee, which is responsible for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
- g. cooperate with the Licensee to provide the capability to link directly from records in the Licensee's bibliographic computing systems, including library web pages, to articles available in the Licensed Electronic Publications through Wiley InterScience when possible.

2. The Licensee will:

- a. take all reasonable measures to inform Authorized Users of the Rules of Use governing access to Wiley InterScience and emphasize to such Authorized Users the need to comply with whatever restrictions on access, use, reproduction and transmission are included therein;
- b. make access available to Authorized Users only through the Licensee's secure network; undertake reasonable measures within its control to prevent access to and improper use of the Electronic Publications and Wiley InterScience by

unauthorized persons; and take responsibility for terminating any unauthorized access of which it has actual notice or knowledge:

- c. provide Wiley with information about the Licensee's IP addresses which can be used by Wiley to authenticate Authorized Users, as listed in Appendix A and updated from time to time;
- d. promptly notify Wiley of any copyright infringement or unauthorized usage of the Electronic Publications which comes to the Licensee's attention; and cooperate with Wiley in the investigation of such infringement or unauthorized use and in any action which Wiley takes to enforce its copyright, at Wiley's expense.

F. **PRIVACY AND DATA PROTECTION POLICY**

Wiley recognizes the importance of protecting the Authorized User information it collects and will take all reasonable steps to maintain the security, integrity and privacy of this information. Wiley will ensure that any information it collects will be adequate, relevant and not excessive for purposes of Wiley InterScience; it will be kept accurate and up-to-date based on information provided and will be deleted when no longer needed. Except where necessary in connection with services provided by appropriate intermediaries, who will be required to comply with the confidentiality provisions of this policy, Wiley will not disclose any personal information identifying Authorized Users or the Licensee to any third party, unless required by law or to enforce Wiley InterScience Terms of Service.

Authorized Users are given the option of creating a personal home page where the Authorized User may store links to favorite journals, favorite articles and search criteria, but Authorized Users do not necessarily have to use a home page. Any private communications or information supplied to Wiley by an Authorized User may be used by Wiley for internal business and research purposes and to help enhance and develop Wiley InterScience but will not be shared with third parties.

Wiley will only disclose to third parties navigational and transactional information in the form of anonymous, aggregate usage statistics (including "hits" on Wiley InterScience and the Licensed Electronic Publications) and demographics in forms that do not reveal an Authorized User's personal identity or private information or the identity of the Licensee, except as required by law.

Links may be provided from Wiley InterScience to other websites. In using such links, Authorized Users should be aware that each website will vary in terms of its privacy and data protection policies, and Wiley does not take responsibility for the privacy policies of, and usage of personal information collected by, others.

G. **TERM AND TERMINATION**

The Term of this License shall commence on the date first above written and end on December 31st, 2001.

2. Wiley shall have the right to terminate access to Wiley InterScience by an Authorized User at any time during the Term if such Authorized User breaches Wiley's Rules of Use or infringes copyright in the Electronic Publications or Wiley InterScience (with notification to the Licensee when possible). The Licensee shall not be responsible for unauthorized use by Authorized Users which is without the express or implied consent of the Licensee, provided that the Licensee has taken reasonable steps to prevent such misuse and, upon learning of it, notifies Wiley promptly of any such breach or infringement.
3. Wiley may terminate this License if the Licensee materially breaches its obligations under this License and fails to cure such material breach, provided that Wiley shall give written notice of its intention to terminate and shall allow the Licensee 90 days after receipt of such notice to remedy the breach.

H. WARRANTY AND DISCLAIMERS BY WILEY

Wiley represents and warrants that it has the right and authority to make Wiley InterScience available to the Licensee and its Authorized Users pursuant to the terms and conditions of this License and that, to the best of Wiley's knowledge, Wiley InterScience and the Electronic Publications do not infringe upon any copyright, patent, trade secret or other proprietary right of any third party.

2. Wiley InterScience may provide Authorized Users with links to third-party websites. Where such links exist, Wiley disclaims all responsibility and liability for the content of such third party websites. Authorized Users assume sole responsibility for the accessing of third party websites and the use of any content on such websites.
3. Except for the warranties in paragraph 1 above,

- b. THE USE OF THE ELECTRONIC PUBLICATIONS, WILEY INTERSCIENCE AND ALL MATERIALS IS AT THE AUTHORIZED USER'S OWN RISK;
- c. ACCESS TO WILEY INTERSCIENCE AND THE ELECTRONIC PUBLICATIONS MAY BE INTERRUPTED AND MAY NOT BE ERROR FREE; AND
- d. NEITHER WILEY INTERSCIENCE, THE ELECTRONIC PUBLICATIONS, WILEY, OR ANYONE ELSE INVOLVED IN CREATING, PRODUCING OR DELIVERING THE ELECTRONIC PUBLICATIONS OR THE MATERIALS CONTAINED IN WILEY INTERSCIENCE, SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY DIRECT, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF THE AUTHORIZED USER'S USE

OF OR INABILITY TO USE WILEY INTERSCIENCE, THE ELECTRONIC
PUBLICATIONS AND ALL MATERIALS CONTAINED THEREIN.

4. Wiley shall indemnify and hold the Licensee harmless from and against any damages, costs and fees (including reasonable attorney's fees) resulting from any judgment against the Licensee arising out of the claim of a third party that Wiley's license of the Licensed Electronic Journals or the Licensee's use thereof constitutes an infringement of any copyright, patent, trade secret or other proprietary right of any such third party. This indemnity shall not apply if the claim involves content which has been modified or otherwise used in a manner not permitted under this License or if the Licensee has failed to comply with other terms of this License.
5. The Licensee shall give prompt notice of an infringement claim to Wiley, provide such cooperation and assistance to Wiley as is reasonably necessary to defend the claim, and shall allow Wiley to have the sole control of the defense, provided, however, that the Licensee retains the right to participate in the defense at its own expense.

CONFIDENTIALITY PROVISIONS

1. While negotiating this License Agreement and during the License Term thereafter, Wiley may provide the Licensee with certain information which may be oral or written (including information in electronic format), which is deemed confidential. For the purposes of this Agreement, Confidential Information is defined to include the terms and conditions of this License Agreement, that have been negotiated, but not limited to the financial terms, the substance of all negotiations relating thereto, all information pertaining to Wiley InterScience which is proprietary to Wiley, and any other material which has either been marked "confidential" by Wiley or which, by the nature of the circumstances surrounding the disclosure, would be understood to be confidential by a reasonable party.
2. Confidential Information shall be used by the Licensee solely for the purposes of negotiating and implementing this License Agreement. Subject to applicable law, the Licensee agrees to take reasonable care to protect the Confidential Information from disclosure to third parties and to limit disclosure of the Confidential Information to those employees or contractors of the Licensee including affiliates of the Licensee who have a need to know in connection with this License Agreement, and who have been made aware of, and agree to abide by, these restrictions.

J YEAR 2000 READINESS DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

This is a *Year 2000 Readiness Disclosure Statement* pursuant to the "Year 2000 Information and Readiness Disclosure Act".

Wiley certifies that the product being provided to the University of California is year 2000 compliant; that is, it will operate properly in the Year 2000 and beyond and in situations where dates of the year 2000 are used. However, Wiley is not responsible for problems with the Licensee's equipment, software, internet service provider, or other potential problems within the telecommunications system at large which may affect the Licensee's ability to access Wiley InterScience.

K. GENERAL PROVISIONS



AMENDMENT TO ENHANCED ACCESS LICENSE

Amendment as of July 1, 2000 to the License Agreement dated December 1, 1999, by and between Wiley Subscription Services, Inc. as Licensors and the Regents of the University of California as Licensee (the "Agreement").

In signing this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

The California State University system ("CSU") shall be added to the definition of Licensee as defined in the Agreement, with access to Wiley InterScience as provided therein.

2. The Regents of the University of California agree to be responsible for payments on behalf of the California State University system.
3. The Regents of the University of California shall be responsible to provide a copy of the Agreement as amended to the CSU which agrees to abide by its obligations and those of its Authorized Users as stated therein.

The following terms shall amend and supersede the terms of said Agreement as follows:


Paragraph G1, "Terms and Termination" is amended and the term of the License is extended to end on December 31, 2003.

2. Appendix B, "Pricing Terms," is amended so that the average list price of the Journals covered by this License will not exceed [REDACTED] than the list price of the prior year.
3. Appendix B, "List of Journals," shall remain the basis for the fees payable hereunder, but Licensors shall provide the Licensee with access to all of the electronic journals available through Wiley InterScience.
4. Appendix B, "Total Enhanced Access Fee," is amended to include the fees payable by the Regents of the University of California on behalf of the California State University system for access hereunder (The fees payable are set forth in the attached spreadsheets, to be added to Appendix B) and incorporated herein.
5. Appendix A, "The Licensee: Name of the Licensee, listing of all sites and of IP address(es) for the Licensee's secure network," is amended to list the campuses of CSU which will be provided access to Wiley InterScience.
6. Appendix C, "Print Subscription Information Detail," is amended to include shipping information.

Except as provided by the Amendments herein stated, all terms and conditions of the License Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.






