

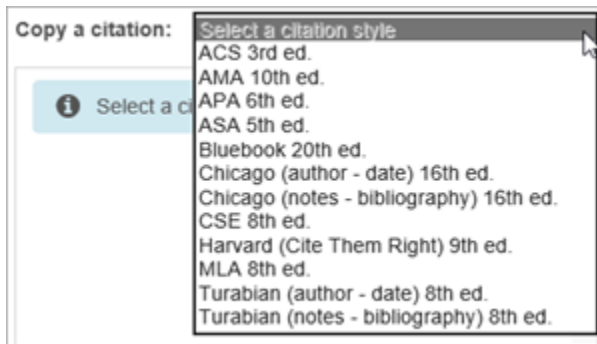
Exporting Records from Melvyl®WCD

Single records

Click the **Cite** button on *Cite/Link/Email/Save* bar at the bottom of the record in the search results display or at the top of the full record display. In the *Cite a Record* box, you can [Export to RefWorks](#) (opens a new window), [Export to EndNote](#) (downloads a file for use in EndNote) or [Export to RIS](#) (downloads a file for use in EasyBib, Mendeley, and Zotero, etc.).



When the *Cite a Record* box displays, select a citation style (APA, Chicago, etc.). See below.



Multiple records

Multiple records can be exported in various ways from a saved list. First, create or sign into your WorldCat Discovery User Account and select the appropriate list from the dropdown menu beneath your account name at the top, right of the screen.

When the list displays, click the **Cite** button to display the *Cite a Record* box.

Export to EndNote

Clicking the [Export to EndNote](#) link downloads a file for use in EndNote.

Export to RefWorks

Clicking the [Export to RefWorks](#) link opens a new window. Please be sure to disable your popup blocker.

Export to RIS

Clicking the [Export to RIS](#) link downloads a file for use in EasyBib, Mendeley, and Zotero, etc.

When the formatted text file displays (see below for an example), save the file and then follow the software's usual procedures for importing records from a saved text file.
