Brief WEST Refresher

WEST Refresher - What we do

Collaborate across the western regional United States to build a shared, retrospective print collection of journals.

Our objectives:

- → Preserve the scholarly print record through distributed retention commitments and targeted consolidation of journal holdings
- → Provide access to retained materials
- → Create opportunities to reallocate library space


Together, WEST members are retaining and providing access to over 830,000 volumes across over 32,000 unique titles.

WEST Refresher - How we do it

- Analyze our collective serial holdings
- Target our effort and resources based on risk for loss of content
- Explicitly <u>record</u> the retentions and <u>disclose</u> them through public registries
- Provide tools for <u>local decision-making and comparison</u>
- Collaborate with the wider community

Vision & Mission

Mission: To collaboratively develop, manage and coordinate the identification, retention, registration, discovery of, and access to a shared, distributed collection of print content across libraries.

Guiding Principles

Shared Responsibility and Stewardship

Our top priority is preserving and making accessible the scholarly record both for our members, and also for the greater good.

Trust and Transparency

Our work is built on a foundation of trust among libraries, supported by complete and accessible documentation and exceptional communication with member libraries.

Inclusion and Diversity

We value diversity and inclusivity in our collaboration. We invite participation from the broadest range of libraries and individuals possible to meet our mission. We are committed to preserving a collective collection that represents the diversity of the communities we serve.

Guiding Principles, continued

Equity

We are committed to pursuing equitable models in stewarding the collective collection - from selection, to discoverability, to access, to governance.

Collaboration

We welcome partnerships with organizations that have a similar mission to preserve the scholarly record.

Sustainability and Resilience

We recognize that librarianship is a dynamic and ever-changing landscape. We commit to anticipating change, adapting to new needs, and expanding the range of WEST members and communities we serve.



Local Discovery of WEST Archived Collections

- Goal: Facilitate discovery of distributed shared collections by local users
 - Connect local users to the broader WEST collections
 - Demonstrate continued availability of titles deaccessioned locally
 - Immediate comparison of local holdings against WEST archives
- First iteration: MARC file now available in AGUA!
- Future work: With peer programs, participate in discussions with vendors to develop better native support for shared print

Downloadable file now available on the AGUA dashboard




Local Discovery of WEST Archives

- 2. New 'Rosemont Archived' field for quick identification (flag if the program is a Rosemont partner)
